

### **RAILWAY 200**

2025 marks the 200th anniversary of the opening of the world's first public railway – the Stockton to Darlington Railway - which made possible the industrial revolution, transformed land transportation and shaped the country as we know it today.

Railway 200 is a high-profile year-long national celebration of this important milestone. The Bluebell Railway in Sussex is an important part of the national programme and will be hosting Railway 200 @ Bluebell Railway - the largest event in London and the South East.

## **BLUEBELL RAILWAY**

The Bluebell Railway is the oldest preserved standard gauge public railway in the world, opening its doors in 1960.

Running for 11 miles through mid-Sussex, we are a leading heritage railway, custodians of the finest private heritage railway collection in Britain and a major film and TV location.

As one of the largest tourist attractions in Sussex, welcoming over 150,000 visitors each year, we're ideally placed to host a major Railway 200 event.

### **OUR EVENT**

Rail Past - at Sheffield Park - will celebrate 200 years of railway history, whilst Rail Present and Future at Horsted Keynes will showcase today's rail industry with a look forward to the railways of 2075.

During the Education Phase in June, we will welcome around 18,000 school children to the railway to learn about the historical importance of railways, the STEM underpinning rail transport, today's rail industry and rail careers. They will also attend a rail safety workshop. This will be followed by a public celebration phase in July and August.
